## **2017 SUMMER INTERN MODEL ARAB LEAGUE**

## **Council on Combatting Insurgency**

- 1. Improving state capacity to preempt the threat posed by socially- and politically-marginalized ethnic and religious groups, particularly as it relates to support for or recruitment into extremist groups.
- 2. Formulating solutions to the problems posed by separatist movements, including but not limited to Kurds and Houthis.
- 3. Mitigating the extent to which extremist organizations are able to obtain illicit means of funding, with a focus on both the suppliers and consumers of the goods.

## **Council on Healthcare in Conflict Zones**

- 1. Facilitating access to healthcare professionals and medical care for those suffering from mental health illnesses and psychological trauma such as Post-Traumatic Stress Disorder (PTSD).
- 2. Devising methods of safely and efficiently distributing humanitarian aid to conflictridden zones.
- 3. Discussing ways in which the League can alleviate the burden on refugees' social and emotional health by reintegrating them into the formal economies of their host nations.

## **Council on Economic and Social Development**

- 1. Establishing education programs, policies, and initiatives to combat the impact of "brain drain" and support the retention of skilled professionals.
- 2. Discussing ways in which League can employ methods such as cultural tourism to benefit the economic development of member states and preserve cultural heritage.
- 3. Reviewing and reforming the Greater Arab Free Trade Area (GAFTA) while emphasizing ways that the League can promote the private sectors and economic diversification of member states.
