Joint Defense Council

- 1. Resolving illicit arms trafficking in former and current conflict zones.
- 2. Creating a League-wide security protocol for natural and man-made disasters to provide safe and sustainable methods of prevention, recovery, and development.
- 3. Considering the growing sophistication of cyberattacks against vulnerable populations and measures to counter the increase in cyber crimes.
- 4. Expanding the EU-LAS project to address cross-border transit security of refugees and other displaced persons.

Council on Palestinian Affairs

- 1. Assessing ways to provide the necessary care to Palestinian orphans while working to keep them under the care of other Palestinians.
- 2. Devising means of reducing Palestinian economic dependence on Israel.
- 3. Protecting and creating infrastructure and services for disabled Palestinians.
- 4. Evaluating the progression of the Palestinian-Israeli conflict and examining means for de-escalation and protection of Palestinians from continued harm.

Council on Political Affairs

- 1. Exploring means for women and underrepresented populations to have equitable access to positions of leadership.
- 2. Examining the role of technology in government accountability and civilian trust.
- 3. Developing strategies to address concerns of protest groups in an effort to increase youth participation in government and prevent radicalization.
- 4. Establishing and enforcing labor standards to expand worker protections in the MENA region.

Council of Arab Social Affairs Ministers

- 1. Assessing the role of artificial intelligence and technology in enhancing equity and accessibility in healthcare systems.
- 2. Promoting global Arabic Studies programs to encourage diplomacy and improve the international reputation of Arab states.
- 3. Evaluating and creating new farming practices and civilian infrastructure throughout the Arab League to help mitigate hunger.
- 4. Enhancing and upholding the rights and protections of displaced persons within the MENA region.

Council of Arab Environmental Affairs Ministers

- 1. Examining the effect of ocean acidification and thermal pollution on ecosystems and food supplies in the MENA region.
- 2. Encouraging the transition to environmentally friendly transportation systems.
- 3. Analyzing the effect of current rapid population growth on natural resources across the Arab League.
- 4. Evaluating member states' international climate commitments and developing strategies to mitigate air pollution in the Arab region.

Council of Arab Economic Affairs Ministers

- 1. Evaluating the effectiveness of tourism and entertainment investments in improving Arab states' economic outlook.
- 2. Assessing current efforts towards diversification away from fossil fuel dependence.
- 3. Investigating and repairing existing systems of income inequality across the League.
- 4. Examining labor supply shortages and barriers to combat skilled worker emigration and youth unemployment.

Summit of Arab Heads of State

- 1. Analyzing the effect of Syria's re-admittance into the Arab League and pursuing the possibility of continued League expansion.
- 2. Recommending ways to protect minority ethnic and tribal groups in the MENA region.
- 3. Evaluating ways to safeguard regional stability against future regime changes.
- 4. Developing League-wide free speech standards while recognizing the role of government authority.

Special Council on Increasing Diplomatic Partnerships

- 1. Considering the Pan Arab Games as a method of unity building within the Arab League.
- 2. Establishing the Arab League's relationship with the Alliance of Small Island States (AOSIS), focusing on tackling linked climate-related crises.
- 3. Evaluating the efficacy of the China-Arab States Cooperation Forum and considering plans for the future strengthening of ties.
- 4. Defining the future goals and involvement of the Arab League states in the Non-Aligned Movement (NAM).

Arab Court of Justice

- 1. *The Kingdom of Jordan v. Syria:* Regarding drug trafficking activity on the border of Jordan.
- 2. The Kingdom of Morocco v. People's Democratic Republic of Algeria: Regarding Morocco's claim to Western Sahara.
- 3. League of Arab States (represented by Bahrain) v. Unaoil (represented by Yemen): Regarding whether Unaoil's operations within the Arab League have violated international law.
- 4. *Qatar v. United Arab Emirates:* Regarding concerns over the Barakah nuclear power plant.
- 5. The Republic of Egypt v. The Democratic Republic of Ethiopia (represented by Mauritania): Regarding the potential effects of the GERD project on Egypt.
